### Exceptional flavour from a vigorous plant full of resistances

The main feature of Prospano, aside its high resistance against ToBRFV, is its 'real' tomato flavour. This TOV has a deep red colour with nice flat trusses which makes packing easy and efficient. The crop itself is also favourable to the grower; with a naturally generative habit the plant has plenty of vigour to deliver good yields. An additional benefit is the presence of mildew resistance and TSWV, which are increasingly becoming an issue.
